Glamis Castle is the childhood home of The Queen Mother and birthplace of the late Princess Margaret, reputed to be the most haunted stately home in Britain. It is above all a family home where The Earl and Countess of Strathmore together with their son Toby reside. For a day trip you could go back in time and see this six-storey tower built in the 15th century castle. You could spend time in the Museum and their beautiful gardens. There is so much history in this castle you will have such a fantastic experience. The tour will then visit Dunfermline's Abbey and Palace which is the final resting-place of some of Scotland's greatest Kings and Queens, the great Benedictine Abbey of Dunfermline occupies an especially important place in the national consciousness. The Royal lodgings at the Abbey developed into a spectacular palace, which became the birthplace of Charles I. Stunning views of the glen can be gained from the palace, which is now a restored ruin, is now maintained by Historic Scotland.
