Introduction

St. Andrews is a beautiful town on the east coast of Scotland named after Scotland's patron saint, St. Andrew. It is the home of the Old Course and the Royal and Ancient Golf Club dating from the 15th Century. The British Golf Museum opposite the Old Course has memorabilia dating back to the origin of the game. St. Andrews is not only famous for golf but also has many historical buildings. Remains of a 12th century cathedral, ruins of a castle dating from 13th century and old churches and towers. The University is the oldest in Scotland. The town also has a Sealife Centre with a shark display and outdoor seal pool. The coach will take you the most scenic route through the 'East Neuk of Fife' passing lovely old fishing villages. Lunch will be at the Dukes Course, which has the most fantastic views over the ancient town. There will be a Professional Guide accompanying this tour.
