Depart Edinburgh to Rosslyn Chapel of the Da Vinci Code fame. Rosslyn Chapel, originally named the Collegiate Chapel of St. Matthew is a 15th century church in the village of Roslin, seven miles from Edinburgh. The chapel is famous both for its decorative art and its mysterious associations with the Knights Templar, the Holy Grail and the Freemasons. Just a short drive away, we will then visit the Edinburgh Crystal Factory to learn something of the mysteries of glass blowing and crystal cutting. Edinburgh Crystal was founded in 1867 and remains at the cutting edge of contemporary crystal design. Their range stretches from classic traditional shapes to the latest in spectacular designer glassware. After your tour round the factory, spend some time and perhaps money in their shop.
